- **Village Corridor / Gateway Beautification Planning:** As reported to the SEC in April, the Village Board directed Staff to enter into an agreement with Teska Associates and Landscape Artistry (Cliff Miller) to begin planning that will support the SEC's beautification mission. The study will kick off at the SEC's June meeting with a stakeholder workshop including representatives from the Village, Lake Bluff Garden Club, Lake Bluff Open Lands, Lake County Department of Transportation, and Illinois Department of Transportation. Their agenda is attached, and this workshop will occupy the balance of the SEC's June meeting.
- **Upcoming Work Plan:** Based on our previous discussions, we understand the SEC's consensus for its next meetings to be:
 - **Completion of the Sustainability Plan and recommendation to Village Board.**
 - **Bicycle parking planning in the Central Business District.**
 - **Dark Sky ordinance study and consideration.**

Absent other direction from the committee, Staff will bring these items forward in July and plan to focus on them through final action by the committee.
