

## Village of Lake Bluff, Illinois One Day Liquor License Application

The Village has three types of one-day liquor licenses (described below) that may be issued in connection with a special or private event. Licenses are granted at the discretion of the Liquor Commissioner, subject to verification of insurance and a background check conducted by the Village.

Licensees must provide proof of insurance with the following limits and requirements, which proof of insurance should be attached to this application:

- Comprehensive general liability insurance with limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate.
- Dram shop liability with the minimum amounts required by State law for liability associated with the sale of liquor.
- Name as an additional insured on a primary and non-contributory basis:
   "The Village of Lake Bluff and its officials, employees, agents and volunteers."
- ISO Endorsements CG 2026 and CG 2001 or equivalent. <u>Endorsements must be provided.</u> Comments on the face of a Certificate of Insurance are not accepted.

• Special Event Permit

A special event permit is also required for events occurring on Village property.

• Liquor Service - State of Illinois Not-For-Profit Liquor License

Under some circumstances, a not-for-profit group may be able to vend liquor even though they do not hold a regular State of Illinois liquor license. Both a Village and State license are required.
