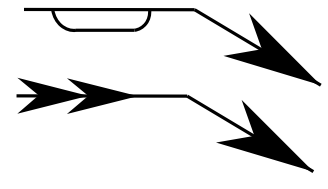
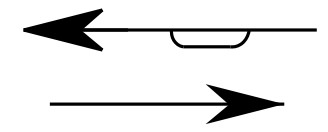

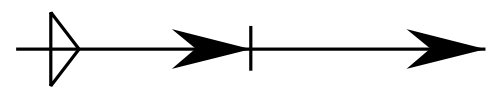
OVERTAKING-SIDESWIPE, SAME DIRECTION

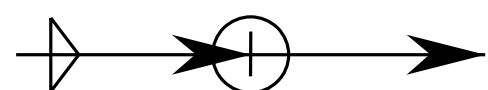

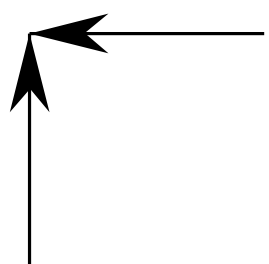

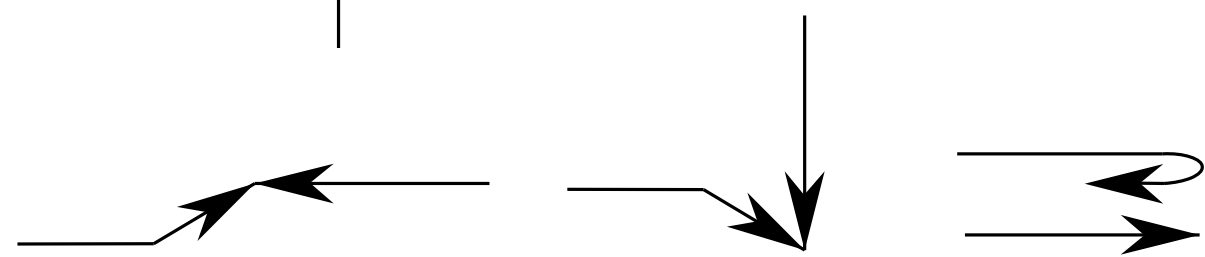

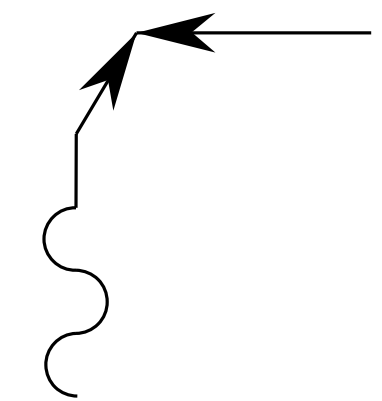

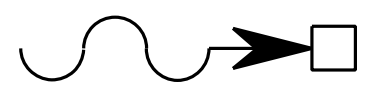

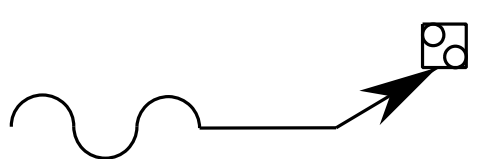

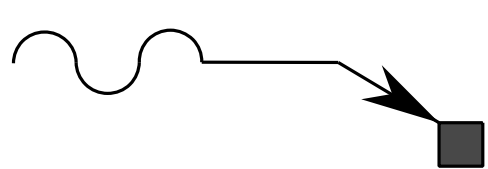

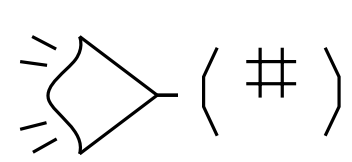
OUT OF CONTROL-FIXED OBJECT (SIGN)

INJURY TYPES

K (FATAL):

DEATHS OCCUR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF CRASH

A-TYPE INJURY:

ANY INJURY OTHER THAN FATAL THAT PREVENTS THE INJURED PERSON FROM WALKING, DRIVING, OR OTHER NORMAL ACTIVITIES (SEVERE LACERATIONS, BROKEN BONES, CHEST AND ABDOMINAL INJURIES, ETC.)

B-TYPE INJURY:

ANY INJURY OTHER THAN A FATAL OR DISABLING INJURY, THAT IS EVIDENT AT THE SCENE OF THE CRASH (ABRASIONS, BRUISES, MINOR LACERATIONS, ETC.)

C-TYPE INJURY:

NO VISIBLE INJURY, BUT THERE ARE COMPLAINTS OF PAIN OR MOMENTARY UNCONSCIOUSNESS
