Green Bay Road Resurfacing Project Update

August 23, 2013 - During the week of August 19th, IDOT's contractor, J.A. Johnson Paving Company (Contractor), completed the removal of the old roadway surface and installed the first of two new layers of asphalt. The final layer of asphalt is scheduled to be placed on Saturday, August 24th. It is anticipated the project will be completed by August 30th. Union Pacific Staircase Reconstruction Update

August 23, 2013 - During the week of August 19th Union Pacific Railroad continued work on the removal and reconstruction of the eastern and western stairways (Project) leading from the sidewalk along IL Rt. 176 to the Metra train station platforms. Union Pacific reports pedestrian traffic along the IL Rt. 176 sidewalk will be maintained; however, brief delays may occur. The work on the easterly staircase has been completed with the exception of landscape restoration. Demolition work on the westerly staircase continues. Union Pacific reports that a new westerly staircase will be in place by August 30th.
