### Labor Day Holiday Reminders

In observance of Labor Day refuse and yard waste collections on Monday, September 2nd will be picked up one day later on Tuesday, September 3rd. Tuesday's collections will be picked up on Wednesday, September 4th. For those households receiving a la carte collection services the second collection day (Thursday or Friday) will remain unchanged. Non-emergency Village offices will be closed on Monday, September 2nd and will commence with regular hours of operation (8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.) on Tuesday, September 3rd. ### Green Bay Road Resurfacing Project Update

**August 30, 2013** - During the week of August 26th, IDOT's contractor, J.A. Johnson Paving Company (Contractor), installed the final layer of new bituminous pavement along Green Bay Road from IL Rt. 176 to the north limit of the Village. The contractor also installed all the new pavement markings (line stripes, turn arrows, stop bars, etc.). The remaining work includes the installation of reflectors in the roadway surface, removal of the temporary pavement marking, and general cleanup and restoration.

### Union Pacific Staircase Reconstruction Update

**August 30, 2013** - During the week of August 26th Union Pacific Railroad continued work on the removal and reconstruction of the eastern and western stairways (Project) leading from the sidewalk along IL Rt. 176 to the Metra train station platforms. Union Pacific reports pedestrian traffic along the IL Rt. 176 sidewalk will be maintained; however, brief delays may occur. The work on the easterly staircase has been completed with the exception of landscape restoration; demolition work on the westerly staircase continues.

### Fall Semi-Annual Collection Information

The fall semi-annual collection program provides Village residents an opportunity to dispose of items such as mattresses, furniture and barbeque grills (without propane tank) that are not picked up as part of

the normal refuse collection. The semi-annual collection schedule is determined by regular collection dates; Pickup for Monday's refuse collection route is Wednesday, October 2nd and Tuesday's refuse collection route is scheduled for Wednesday, October 9th. Residents are reminded that all items are required to be placed at the curb no earlier than 4:00 p.m. the day prior to the collection.
