Union Pacific Staircase Reconstruction Update

September 13, 2013 - During the week of September 9th Union Pacific Railroad (UP) continued work on the removal and reconstruction of the eastern and western stairways (Project) leading from the sidewalk along IL Rt. 176 to the Metra Train Station platforms. The easterly staircase has been reopened and all work has been completed except for landscape restoration. UP has completed the pouring of the concrete on the westerly staircase; however, the staircase will remain closed until the new metal handrails are installed. According to UP the Project will be completed during the week of September 16th.
