Veteran's Day Ceremony Hosted by American Legion - November 11th

The Lake Bluff Veteran's Day Ceremony, conducted by the Lake Bluff American Legion Post 510, is scheduled for November 11th at 9:00 a.m. on the Village Green.

State Senator Julie Morrison and State Representative Scott Drury will read the names of local casualties. Post 510 Commander David Cimarrusti will host. Colonel Neal F. McIntyre, US Army, will be the Guest Speaker.

Terry Leone, Lake Bluff Women's Club President will lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Pastor Mark Hindman, Union Church, Lake Bluff, will deliver the Invocation and Benediction. Boy Scout Troop 42 will conduct the flag ceremony.

Lake Forest High School Band, directed by Janene Kessler, will provide music. LFHS student Grant Papastefan will sing the Star Spangled Banner and America The Beautiful. LFHS Buglers Timothy Walther and Thomas Balk will perform Taps and Echo. Lake Bluff Middle School Student Council President Ursela Nugent will deliver the Gettysburg Address.

The Marine Rifle Squad from Marine Air Control Group #48, Great Lakes, lead by SNCOIC Gy/Sgt Escobar, will perform rifle volleys. A wreath will be laid at the Veterans Memorial. Refreshments will be served in the Community Room of the Lake Bluff Public Safety Building after the program.

To commemorate Veterans Day the Lake Bluff History Museum is sponsoring a display of military items from Lake Bluff residents.

in the proper disposal of leaves, brush and other landscape waste this season, the Village offers the following disposal guidelines:

- Bundle or bag landscape waste in a Kraft-type paper bag (available at home improvement stores everywhere) no larger than 32 gallon capacity or 50 pounds in weight;
- Individual pieces of brush and/or branches are not to exceed 6 inches in diameter;
- Bundle waste to ensure it does not exceed 2 feet in diameter and 4 feet in length overall or exceed 50 pounds; and
- Ensure bundled waste is securely tied with only twine as plastic, metal or rope ties are prohibited at compost sites.

The Village encourages residents who use professional landscapers for yard maintenance to share these guidelines with the crew members.
