Village Board to Consider FY2014-2015 Budget on March 10, 2014

On March 10, 2014 the Village Board will conduct a Public Hearing on the Tentative Annual Budget for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2014 and ending April 30, 2015. Copies of the Tentative Annual Budget will be available for public inspection in advance of the meeting at Village Hall, the Public Safety Building, the Lake Bluff Library and online at lakebluff.org. Following the Public Hearing the Tentative Annual Budget may be further revised and passed without any further inspection, notice or hearing.

LEAD Hosts Meeting on Heroin Use in Lake County, 2/26/14

Lake County State's Attorney Mike Nerheim headlines this community panel that will cover heroin education and local solutions on Wednesday, Feb 26 from 7:00 – 8:30 p.m. at Gorton Community Center.

Residents are invited to a presentation, hosted by Leading Efforts Against Drugs (LEAD), concerning the increased heroin situation in Lake County and what we can do as a community to create solutions. A general overview of heroin use in Lake County will be presented and then attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions of the community panel.

The community panel will consist of a Mike Nerheim, Cliff Rice (ER physician and community member), Heather Hale (Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor), a recovering young person and a member of the Lake Forest Police Department.
