Due to severe icing on Lake Michigan, the 2014 Polar Plunge was not held at the lake front last week; however, a big thank you to the volunteers of the Lake Bluff Fire Department for assisting in setting up "drafting pools." Typically, drafting pools are used to hold water for fire department tankers in areas without hydrant service. Plungers were still able to participate by wading in the pools in the below freezing weather and snowfall. A total of 224 people participated and raised \$94,000 for Illinois Special Olympics. The event was conducted by the Illinois Special Olympics, the Lake Bluff Police Department, and the Lake Bluff Park District.
