### FY2014-15 Annual Budget Passes First Reading; Final Reading Scheduled for April 14, 2014

On March 10, 2014 the Village Board conducted a Public Hearing on the Tentative Annual Budget for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2014 and ending April 30, 2015. Following the presentation, the Village Board unanimously approved first reading of the Budget Ordinance. The Village Board will consider second and final reading on April 14th. Copies of the Tentative Annual Budget are available for public inspection at Village Hall, the Public Safety Building, the Lake Bluff Library and online following this article.

Following the Public Hearing the Tentative Annual Budget may be further revised and passed without any further inspection, notice or hearing.
