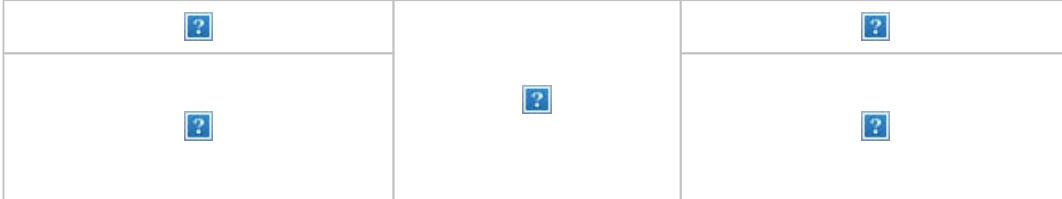

The Village of Lake Bluff is in the process of gathering information about parking in downtown in order to accomplish the following:

- Maximize the effectiveness and efficiencies of existing parking infrastructure; and
- Identify trends that may require additional resources or improvements.

A key element of this effort is a professional parking study that is currently underway. The study is being conducted by Rich and Associates, a parking consultant firm that specializes in assessing current parking needs, projecting future demands, and analyzing current and future development plans, specifically related to parking.
