Approved Street Resurfacing Program for FY14-15

Earlier this year the Village Board approved a resolution appropriating \$490,000 (\$308,000 of which is from the IL Motor Fuel Tax) from the Village's General Fund to complete the scheduled Roadway Resurfacing Project during fiscal year 2014-2015. Consistent with the Village's 2016 Strategic Plan goals, the Village partnered with the City of Lake Forest to jointly bid the 2014-15 roadway resurfacing work. A joint project was prepared because it is believed a larger contract will result in lower unit prices for the work being performed in each community. The Village anticipates work to begin this summer and will resurface all or portions of 10 streets in the Village. Streets are selected for repair based upon available resources and a survey taken in the fall of each year. Residents living on streets where resurfacing is scheduled will receive information before the work commences.

The roadways scheduled for resurfacing this year include:
