### Spring Semi-Annual Collections Scheduled

During the first two weeks of May, the Village of Lake Bluff provides its residents an opportunity to dispose of large items not picked up as part of the normal refuse collection program at no additional charge.

- Collection for Lake Bluff residents with Monday refuse collection is scheduled for Wednesday, May 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Residents with Tuesday refuse collection is scheduled on Wednesday, May 14<sup>th</sup>.
- Residents are reminded that on the designated collection day, all items are required to be placed at the curb no earlier than 4:00 p.m. the day prior to the collection.

Appliances will be accepted provided that all restricted parts and/or chemicals, such as Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) or mercury switches have been removed. All appliances must display a tag issued by a technician licensed to perform such removals, which provides proof that those substances have been removed. Household chemicals such as paints, motor oil, and household cleaners are not accepted during any waste pick-up. For information on how to dispose of household chemical waste products, please contact the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County at 847-336-9340.

In addition to the semi-annual collection, Lake Bluff Public Works Department maintains a recycling facility (640 Rockland Road) that is open seven days a week for Village residents to dispose of regular recyclable items (same items disposed of during regular collections) at no extra cost. This convenient service is available to residents displaying a Lake Bluff vehicle sticker, Monday through Friday (from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and on Saturday and Sunday (from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.). ### Safety Tips

The Lake Bluff Police want to remind residents that most burglaries are a crime of opportunity. Often burglars enter homes, businesses or vehicles through open or unlocked garages, doors or windows. The following tips are offered to help reduce the chances of becoming a victim:

- Make your home look occupied, and make it difficult to break in. Don't leave bikes or other items which could be stolen sitting unattended in front yards or driveways.
- Lock all outside doors and windows before you leave the house or go to bed. Even if it is for a short time, lock your doors.
- Leave lights on when you go out. If you are going to be away for a length of time, connect some lamps to automatic timers to turn them on in the evening and off during the day. Leaving a TV or radio on also makes it appear as if someone is home and awake.
- Keep your garage door closed and locked. Never leave the keys in your car, and place them somewhere safe when not being used.
- Check your locks on doors and windows and replace them with secure devices as necessary.
- Sliding glass doors are vulnerable. Special locks are available for better security.
- Other windows may need better locks. Check with a locksmith or hardware store for alternatives.

And just as important, always report suspicious people or vehicles by calling the Lake Bluff Police at 847-234-2151 or 9-1-1.
