Police See Results in Driving Enforcement Campaign

From November 17 through 30, 2014 the Lake Bluff Police Department participated with the IL Department of Transportation, the IL State Police and local law enforcement agencies across the State to save more lives by strongly enforcing seat belt and impaired driving laws. This enforcement included extra traffic enforcement officers funded by federal traffic safety funds, through an Illinois Department of Transportation grant. According to the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), seat belts saved over 12,000 lives nationwide in 2012. Buckle up and encourage your loved ones to do the same. You will save the cost of a ticket and may even save a life.

During the mobilization the Lake Bluff Police Department issued:

- 12 seat belt citations
- 4 child car seat citations
- 4 DUI arrests
- 5 suspended/revoked/invalid licenses
- 10 uninsured motorists
- 8 speeding citations; and
- 15 speeding warnings
