[IL Rt. 176 Roadway Construction Project Update](#)

As part of the [Target Store Development](#) (southwest corner of Rt. 176/41) there are several off site improvements moving forward, including the construction of:

- a dedicated north bound turn lane on west bound Rt. 176 at Waukegan Road;
- an enhanced four way intersection at Rt. 176 and Shagbark:
 - addition of a left turn lane onto Rt. 176 from Shagbark,
 - addition of a left turn lane onto Shagbark from Rt. 176,
 - addition of a right turn lane onto Rt. 176 from Shagbark, and
 - addition of a right turn lane onto Shagbark from Rt. 176;
- a dedicated left turn lane onto Carriage Park Ave. from Waukegan Rd.;
- dedicated right and left turn lanes onto Waukegan Rd. from

- Carriage Park Ave.; and
- dedicated right and left turn lanes onto Waukegan Rd. from Albrecht Drive.

June 5, 2015: During the week of June 1st contractors: i) paved the binder course on IL Rt. 176 eastbound right-turn lane into the Target development, as well as the east side of Shagbark Rd. (portion north of IL Rt. 176); ii) completed resurfacing of Carriage Park Ave. (at IL Rt. 43); and iii) continued work on new traffic signal installation. Contractors are scheduled (weather permitting) to start roadway resurfacing work on Shagbark Rd. and IL Rt. 176 (from Shagbark Rd. to Thorntree) on June 6th. During the week of June 8th contractors anticipate: i) continuing with traffic signal installation work; ii) finishing roadway resurfacing work; iii) installing permanent striping; and iv) continuing with landscape work. As construction continues near the bike path, bicyclists should be alert and use caution while passing through the construction zone.
