In observance of Labor Day, refuse and yard waste collections on Monday, September 7th will be picked up one day later on Tuesday, September 8th. Tuesday's collections will be picked up on Wednesday, September 9th. For those households receiving a la carte collection services the second collection day (Thursday or Friday) will remain unchanged.

The semi-annual collection schedule is determined by regular collection dates; Pickup for Monday's refuse collection route is Wednesday, October 7th and Tuesday's refuse collection route is scheduled for Wednesday, October 14th. Residents are reminded that all items are required to be placed at the curb no earlier than 4:00 p.m. the day prior to the collection.
