### [Halloween and Trick-or-Treat Safety Tips](#)

The Lake Bluff Police Department will host the annual Halloween Hot Dog Roast during trick-or-treat hours on Oct 31<sup>st</sup> from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Public Safety Building. To assist parents in preparing their young ghosts and goblins for a fun and safe Halloween night, the Lake Bluff Police Department offers the following tips:

- Walk on the sidewalk, not in the street;
  - Look both ways before crossing the street and only cross at designated crosswalks, not between parked cars;
  - Wear light-colored or reflective clothing to increase visibility;
  - Carry a flashlight with fresh batteries;
  - Visit homes that have inside and outside lights illuminated;
  - Accept treats at the door and never enter the house;
  - Use face paint rather than wearing masks that obstruct a child's vision;
  - Be cautious of animals and strangers;
  - Have an adult inspect trick-or-treat candy before eating it; and
  - Teach children to obtain help or call 9-1-1 if there is an emergency and stay in groups that are under adult supervision.
