The 5th annual Northwestern Medicine Lake Bluff Criterium & Block Party returns to Lake Bluff on Saturday, July 23, 2016. Fast-paced bicycle racing begins at 9:00 a.m. and the world-class pro racers begin at 4:00 p.m. New categories this year include a hand cycling race for people with physical disabilities and novel fixed gear races on bicycles with no brakes!



In addition, the kids' fun races will begin at 6:05 p.m. Kids ages 3-9 can take part in the bike races, but are allowed to race at their own pace within their own age group. A parent or guardian must register each participant in advance. Registration will take place at the Lake Bluff branch of the Lake Forest Bank from July 18 (Monday) to July 22, 2016 (Friday) from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., and on July 23, 2016 (day of races) from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Registration after 12:00 p.m. on July 23rd will also be available at

the Lake Bluff Fire Station (45 E. Center Ave.). There is no entry fee for kids; however, all participating kids must wear a helmet.

The Block Party (located on the Village Green) is scheduled from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. with music beginning at 8:00 pm. Spectators can view the racing action either live, or from the Jumbotron screen, and enjoy food from several local restaurants, libations and live music.
