### [Lake Bluff Police Hosts Halloween Event and Offers Safety Tips](#)

The Lake Bluff Police Department invites trick-or-treaters to stop by the Public Safety Building (45 E. Center Avenue) for the annual hot dog roast on Monday, October 31<sup>st</sup> during trick-or-treat hours (4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.). The Police Department personnel, with help from their families, will cook hot dogs and serve potato chips and refreshments. Hot dogs are limited, so plan to come early.

### Stay Safe this Halloween

On Halloween armies of ghosts and goblins will descend on Village neighborhoods! The Lake Bluff Police Department offers the following safety tips to help prepare these frightening creatures for a safe and candy-filled Trick-or-Treat experience:

- Walk on the sidewalk, not in the street;
- Look both ways before crossing the street to check for vehicles;

- Only cross the street at designated crosswalks;
- Do not hide or cross the street between parked cars;
- Wear light-colored, reflective-type clothing or affix reflective tape to costumes or treat bags to increase visibility;
- Carry a flashlight with fresh batteries;
- Visit homes that have inside and outside lights illuminated;
- Accept treats at the door and never enter someone's home;
- Use face paint rather than masks or items that will cover a child's eyes. If a mask is worn, ensure that the eyeholes are large enough that the child's vision is unobstructed;
- Be cautious of animals and strangers;
- Have an adult inspect trick-or-treat candy before children eat it. Do not eat candy if the packaging has already been opened;
- Teach children how to obtain help or how to call 9-1-1 if they have an emergency or become lost;
- Discuss appropriate child behavior when celebrating Halloween;
- Take extra care to remove tripping hazards on private property;
- Always keep Jack O' Lanterns away from drapes, decorations, or areas where children will be standing or walking; and
- Stay in groups that are under adult supervision.

### [Moffett Road Culvert Reconstruction Project Update](#)

V3 Construction Group (Contractor) completed its work on the Moffett Rd. Culvert Reconstruction Project. The stabilizing of the slope on the east side of Moffett Road where it crosses the ravine is complete along with the repair of the curb and pavement along the east edge of Moffett Road. The project will stabilize the roadway until the slope can be permanently repaired, which is currently planned for 2018. ### [Upcoming Green Bay Road Pedestrian Path Work](#)

The Village's contractor, Peter Baker and Son (Contractor), is scheduled to begin the resurfacing of the pedestrian path along the west side of Green Bay Road, between Belle Foret Dr. and the north end of the Lake Bluff Elementary School (Project) during the week of October 31, 2016. The Project includes: i) removing the existing path, ii) eliminating uneven areas where needed, and iii) placing new asphalt surface. The Project will address the deterioration of the path, which was constructed approximately 25 years ago. The path at this location will be closed through the duration of the work and the Contractor anticipates completing the Project (weather pending) during mid-November.
