Don't forget Daylight Saving Time ends this weekend. Turn your clocks back one hour on Saturday before bedtime. This is also a good opportunity to test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, and a reminder to replace their batteries.

[Upcoming Green Bay Road Pedestrian Path Work](#)

The Village's contractor, Peter Baker and Son (Contractor), anticipates continuing its work on the resurfacing of the pedestrian path along the west side of Green Bay Road, between Belle Foret Dr. and the north end of the Lake Bluff Elementary School (Project), during the week of November 7th. The Project has been delayed due to wet weather conditions. The Project includes: i) removing the existing path, ii) eliminating uneven areas, and iii) placing new asphalt surface. The Project will address the deterioration of the path, which was constructed approximately 25 years ago. The path at this location will be closed through the duration of the work and the Contractor

anticipates completing the Project (weather pending) mid-November.

[Area Veterans to be Honored on Veterans Day](#)

American Legion Post 510 will conduct the annual Veterans Day ceremony on the Village Green on November 11th (9:00 a.m.) to honor the men and women of America's armed forces. Post 510 Commander David Cimarrusti will host the event. Village President Kathy O'Hara will lead the Pledge of Allegiance and Boy Scout Troop 42 will conduct the flag ceremony.

A Commander, Military Entrance Processing Command, Great Lakes, is the Guest Speaker. The Lake Bluff History Museum President Cathy McKechny will read a WWI soldier's impression of the first "Armistice Day" from her uncle's 1918 diary. Fourth of July Parade Committee President Deb Dintruff and Committee Vice President Charlie Spencer will read the Necrology. Reverend Michael Nacius, Pastor, The Parish of Saint Mary's, (Lake Forest) will deliver the Invocation and Benediction.

Lake Forest High School's Band, directed by Brian O'Connor, will provide music. A LFHS student will sing the *Star Spangled Banner* and *America The Beautiful*. LFHS Buglers percussionists will perform *Taps and Echo*. Lake Bluff Middle School Student Council Representative Taylor Brinker will deliver the *Gettysburg Address*.

Marine Air Control Group #48's rifle squad, lead by GySgt. Dennis Jones, will perform 21-gun volley "*Salute the Dead*". A wreath will be laid at the Veterans Memorial after which refreshments will be served in the Community Room at the Lake Bluff Public Safety Building.
