[Green Bay Road Pedestrian Path Work Update](#)

The Village's contractor, Peter Baker and Son, has completed the majority of the Green Bay Road pedestrian path resurfacing work, between Belle Foret Dr. and the north end of the Lake Bluff Elementary School (Project). The Project included: i) removal of the existing path, ii) elimination of uneven areas, and iii) placement of a new asphalt surface. The Project addressed the deterioration of the path, which was constructed approximately 25 years ago. Minor cleanup work remains; however, the path is now open for use.

[Avoid Becoming a Victim of Package Theft](#)

The holidays are near, and it's that time of year again when homeowners are having packages delivered to their homes. Since many times packages are delivered during the time when no one is home, the Lake Bluff Police Department offers residents the following tips to avoid becoming a victim of package theft:

- If possible, have packages delivered to your workplace;

- Have packages delivered to a place where they can be received in person, such as the home of a trusted neighbor who stays home during the day, or a retired relative;
- Request the shipper require a signature confirmation or hold your package at their pick-up facility to be picked up in-person at your convenience;
- If available, request store delivery;
- Request a specific delivery date and time from the shipper when you know you will be home;
- Provide delivery instructions to the shipper so that packages can be left at a safe location at your home that is out of sight from the street; and
- Sign up for delivery alerts from the shipper.
