[Metra Commuter Parking Lot Ticket Machine Reminder](#)

The Village kindly reminds customers of the Metra Commuter Parking Lot (east side of the tracks) to remember your ticket after making a purchase at the pay box. This ticket must be placed on your vehicle's dashboard to allow the Lake Bluff Police to easily read the ticket during their parking enforcement rounds.

From time to time, customers forget their ticket after making a purchase at the pay box. This may result in the police issuing you a citation, and may cause the pay box printer to jam. In an effort to not inconvenience your fellow commuters please ensure you remove the ticket from the pay box printer and place it on your vehicle's dashboard before exiting your vehicle.

Residents may register to vote by visiting the [Lake County Clerk's Office](#). In addition to the County Clerk's Office, you may also register at the [Shields Township](#) building, 906 Muir Avenue, and at the [Lake Bluff Public Library](#), 123 E. Scranton Ave., Lake Bluff, IL 60044. In order to register, you must be a U.S. citizen, be 18 years of age or older before the next election, and provide two forms of identification – at least one of the two forms must show your name and current address. Only one form of identification may be a piece of mail (e.g. water bill, utility bill).

Your voter registration does not expire unless you move or change your name. Residents must re-register to vote even if you have just moved across the street.

On Tuesday, April 4th, elections will be held for Village President (1), Village Trustee (3), Village Clerk (1) and Library Trustee (4). The following are important dates regarding the 2017 Consolidate Election:

- March 7th - Last day for voter registration;
- March 13th - Voting by mail begins in the County Clerk's office;
- March 20th - Early voting begins;
- April 3rd - Early voting ends; and
- April 4th - Election Day.
