Recent Committee of the Whole (November 13):

- Discussed a recommendation by the SEC regarding a pilot program for beekeeping and chicken keeping in residential areas.

Recent Village Board Meeting (November 13):

- Estimated the amount of the upcoming property tax levy.
- Contracted for the purchase of rock salt for snow and ice

removal.

- Engaged an engineering firm to observe construction of recently approved sanitary sewer lift station projects.
- Approved a tentative and final plat of subdivision for property located at 664 Pine Court.
- Approved a license agreement to allow private use and maintenance of the eastern portion of the Public Safety Building property (45 E. Center Ave.)

Recent Joint Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting (November 15):

- Recommended the Board approve a variation for 718 Sheridan Road (Setback variation)
- Recommended the Board approve, with conditions, zoning relief for Chevy Exchange (Special use permit and variations; 1 Sherwood Terrace and 915 Sherwood Drive).
