### Village News

**BUDGET ADOPTION:** The [FY 2019-2020 biennial budget](#) will be adopted Monday night. It includes less than a 2% increase in operating expenses, but over \$4.8 million in capital investments in Lake Bluff next year.

**SHORT-TERM RENTALS:** The Village Board of Trustees will consider a second and final reading of short-term rentals regulations Monday night at 7 p.m.

**STORMWATER SOLUTIONS:** Village Engineer Jeff Hansen will give an informative presentation to the Sustainability and Community Enhancement Committee on stormwater management next Wednesday at 7 p.m., Village Hall.

**VEHICLE STICKERS:** This is your last week to renew your vehicle sticker before a late fee applies.

**PRINT NEWSLETTER:** You should have received a copy of the [Village quarterly newsletter](#) in your mailbox this week.

- Recommended the Village Board approve a subdivision and variations at 501 & 517 E. Center Ave.
- Discussed the Village's Comprehensive Plan and a proposal to establish a RIO (Institutional Zoning) district.

### Recent Police Pension Board Meeting (April 19):

- Adjusted equity investments, including a policy amendment to limit equities allocations to a maximum of 65% of the fund.
- Transferred \$30,000 for annuitant payments until additional property tax monies are received.
