STREET IMPROVEMENTS: The Village's contractor, Peter Baker and Sons, began sidewalk, curb, and gutter work on ten Village streets this week. Asphalt work on these streets is scheduled to start May 9 (except for school routes).

BUDGET ADOPTION: The [FY 2019-2020 biennial budget](#) was adopted Monday night. It includes less than a 2% increase in operating expenses, but over \$4.8 million in capital investments in Lake Bluff throughout the next year.
