Recent Village Board Meeting (June 25). The Board approved:

- A sign exemption for Whitehead Studios (36 E. Center Ave.)
- Collective bargaining agreement with the police officers union.
- Contractual amendments necessary to receive additional funding from Metra for train station repairs.
- Amendments to employment agreements for the Chief of Police and Village Administrator.
- Disposal of old audio/visual equipment.

Recent Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Special Meeting (June 26). The PCZBA:

- Recommended the Village Board approve a text amendment and special use permit to allow an animal hospital to open at 968 North Shore Drive.
- Approved a front yard impervious surface variation for a circle drive at 40 Oak Terrace.
- Approved a corner lot side yard variation for a covered front

porch at 102 W. Washington Ave.

**Recent Sustainability and Community Enhancement Ad Hoc Committee Meeting (June 27). The Committee:**

- Conducted a stakeholder workshop for a beautification study of the Village's key corridors, including Route 176.
- Discussed its upcoming workplan for summer and fall 2018.
