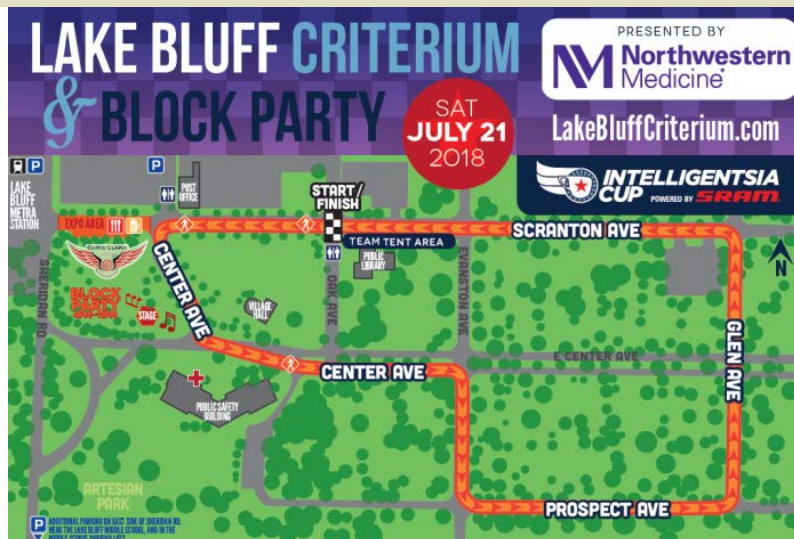

Recent Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting (July 18). The PCZBA:

- Recommended the Village Board approve a front yard setback variation for 673 Maple Avenue.
- Recommended the Village Board deny a minimum lot size variation and subdivision for 419 East Prospect Avenue, which has since been withdrawn.

Recent Police Pension Board Meeting (July 19). The PPB elected its officers, reviewed investments and disability determinations, and requested the Village solicit proposals for legal services.

There will be no Committee of the Whole on July 23.

Upcoming Finance Committee Meeting (July 23). The Committee will discuss the Village's proposal to the Rockland Fire Protection District, the Lake Bluff Mosquito Abatement District, the Village's capital asset and investment policies, on-line credit card payments for Village bills and invoices, and its sales tax rebate.

Upcoming Village Board Meeting (July 23). The Board will consider:

- Appointing Ms. Emma Johnson to the Sustainability and Community Enhancement Ad Hoc Committee
- Second reading of zoning relief necessary to allow an animal hospital to open at 968 North Shore Drive.
- Honoring the public service of Bill Goodman.
- Approving a site plan for the re-roof of the Lake Bluff Library and History Museum, and waiving associated fees.
- Entering into contracts for:
 - Storm outfall repairs at Glen & Sylvan
 - Phase 1 design of Green Bay Road
 - Sanitary sewer evaluation
 - Historic architecture survey of the certain areas of the Village
- A front yard variation for 673 Maple Avenue.
- Amending contracts and fees regarding mobile parking payments.
- Imposing fees for small wireless facilities in accordance with State law.

The Sustainability and Community Enhancement Ad Hoc Committee meeting scheduled for July 25 is CANCELLED.
