Recent Finance Committee Meeting (July 23). The Committee discussed the Village's proposal to the Rockland Fire Protection District, the Lake Bluff Mosquito Abatement District, the Village's capital asset and investment policies, on-line credit card payments for Village bills and invoices, and its sales tax rebate.

Recent Village Board Meeting (July 23). The Board:

- Appointed Ms. Emma Johnson to the Sustainability and Community Enhancement Ad Hoc Committee
- Granted approval for an animal hospital to open at 968 North Shore Drive.
- Honored the public service of Bill Goodman.
- Approved a site plan for the re-roof of the Lake Bluff Library and History Museum, and waived associated fees.
- Entered into contracts for:
 - Storm outfall repairs at Glen & Sylvan
 - Phase 1 design of Green Bay Road
 - Sanitary sewer evaluation
 - Historic architecture survey of the certain areas of the Village
- Approved a front yard variation for 673 Maple Avenue.
- Amended contracts and fees regarding mobile parking payments.
- Imposed fees for small wireless facilities in accordance with State law.

The Sustainability and Community Enhancement Ad Hoc Committee meeting scheduled for July 25 was cancelled.
