The Village Board did not meet on August 13.

The Architectural Board of Review met August 14. The Board:

- Recommended the Village Board approve site plan for a patio and pergola at 525 E. Prospect Ave. (Union Church)
- Approved new antennas and equipment on the cell tower at 45 E. Center Ave. (Public Safety Building)

The Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals met August 15. The PCZBA:

- Recommended the Village Board relax the requirements to install solar energy systems in residential areas.
- Recommended the Village Board grant a special use permit for a building mounted (e.g. rooftop) solar energy system at 600 Arbor Drive.
- Recommended the Village Board relax the requirements to install swimming pools in residential areas.

There are no public meetings scheduled the week of August 20.
