#### Recent Village Board Meeting (September 10). The Board:

- Approved contract for additional modifications to the Village Hall Board Room audio / visual system.
- Approved relaxing the requirements to install solar energy systems in residential areas.

#### Recent Architectural Board of Review Meeting (September 11). The Board:

- Recommended approval of a site plan for sound attenuating hoods at 700 E. Blodgett Avenue.
- Recommended approval of a sign variance for 917 Sherwood Drive with a reduction in size.
- Recommended approval for 101 S. Waukegan Road.
- Reviewed proposed landscaping at the Train Station.

#### Recent Historic Preservation Commission Meeting (September 12). The Commission:

- Recommended approval of a landmark nomination for 502 East Prospect Avenue.
- Recommended approval of a landmark nomination for 406 East

Prospect Avenue.

- Directed a public hearing be held in October to designate 419 East Prospect Avenue as a landmark.
- Continued its strategic planning and visioning.
- *(Pending landmark nominations for 415 E. Prospect Avenue and 400 Ravine Avenue will be considered in October)*

**Upcoming Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting (Monday, September 17).** The PCZBA will:

- Consider a floor area ratio variation for 700 E. Center Ave. to allow a new shed to be constructed.
- Conduct a preliminary workshop regarding a new office building at the property located at 999 & 1001 Sherwood Drive (Smedbo).
- Discuss possible changes to above-ground swimming pool regulations.
- Discuss a proposed "RIO" (institutional) zoning district.
