Recent Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting (September 17). The PCZBA:

- Recommended the Village Board approve a floor area ratio variation for 700 E. Center Ave. to allow a new shed to be constructed.
- Conducted a preliminary workshop regarding a new office building at the property located at 999 & 1001 Sherwood Drive (Smedbo).
- Recommended the Village Board make no regulatory changes specific to above-ground swimming pool.
- Discussed a proposed "RIO" (institutional) zoning district.

Recent Finance Committee Meeting (September 20). The Finance Committee:

- Reviewed a draft of the FY2017 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report.
- Discussed estimates regarding the 2018 property tax levy.
- Recommended changes to the Village's capital asset policy.
