Recent Village Board Meeting (September 24). The Board:

- Accepted the FY2017 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report.
- Appointed Tim Morris to the Police Pension Fund.
- Granted site plan approval of sound attenuating hoods for the CLCJAWA plant at 700 E. Blodgett Ave.
- Approved a sign exemption request for 101 S. Waukegan Rd. (NorthShore Medical Group).
- Revised the Village's capital asset policy.
- Completed first reading of ordinances to designate 406 E. Prospect Ave. and 502 E. Prospect Ave. as historic landmarks.
- Completed first reading of zoning code changes to relax the standards for the location of swimming pools, except for an amendment to further regulate above-ground pools.
- Approved a contract for the Village's 2018 water valve assessment program.
- Amended the Village's pay plan concerning part-time fire and emergency medical staffing.
- Approved a variation for 700 E. Center Ave. to allow a new shed to be constructed.
- Approved a subdivision for 202 Ravine Forest Dr.

Upcoming Architectural Board of Review Meeting (October 2). The ABR will consider:

- Site plan approval for exterior lighting replacement at the CLCJAWA Plant (200 Rockland).
- Sign approvals for the Lake Bluff Middle School and District Offices (31 & 121 E. Sheridan Pl.); 917 Sherwood Drive; and 303

Waukegan Rd.

- Proposed tree grates along Block One in the central business district, and exterior changes to the Walnut House (611 Walnut Avenue).

Upcoming Sustainability and Community Enhancement Ad Hoc Committee Meeting (October 3). The SEC will conduct its second workshop to develop Lake Bluff's Landscape Identity and Route 176 Corridor Enhancement Plan.
