Recent Historic Preservation Commission Meeting (October 10). The HPC:

- Recommended the Village Board designate 415 East Prospect Avenue as a historic landmark.
- Recommended the Village Board designate 400 Ravine Avenue as a historic landmark.
- Recommended the Village Board designate the original home structure located at 419 East Prospect Avenue as a historic landmark.

Upcoming Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting (October 17). The PCZBA will consider:

- An amendment to the Blair Park special use permit to extend the hours the paddle court may operate.
- Amending the sign code to make miscellaneous changes recommended by the Architectural Board of Review.
- Amending the zoning code to consolidate and modify parking requirements in business and industrial districts.
- Amending the zoning code to increase the permissible height in the L-1 and L-2 Light Industry (Business Park) districts and the Service district.
- A workshop concerning a proposed RIO (institutional) zoning district.
- Upcoming work planning.
