The Village Board Meeting scheduled for October 8 was canceled.

Recent Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting (October 17). The PCZBA:

- Recommended a 15-minute extension on Wednesday night for league play at the Blair Park paddle courts.
- Recommended changes to increase the maximum height in the L-1 and L-2 Light Industry (Business Park) districts, and changes to parking regulations in various districts.
- Agreed to hold a public hearing to establish a RIO (institutional) zoning district in early December.
- Recommended amendments to the Village's sign code to permanently authorize common exceptions for businesses.

Upcoming Village Board Meeting (October 22). The Village Board will consider:

- Proclaiming October as "Dysautonomia Awareness Month" and the week of October 23 as "Red Ribbon Week."
- Authorizing a fire automatic aid agreement with the Village of Libertyville.
- Designating an additional vehicle as an authorized emergency vehicle of the Fire Department.
- Approving a site plan for LED light replacements at the CLCJAWA water plant (200 Rockland Road).
- Approving sign exemption requests at 917 Sherwood Drive and 303 Waukegan Road.
- Authorizing a liquor license for a new restaurant at 303 Waukegan Road (El Norte).
- Designating the following addresses as Village historic landmarks:
 - 406 East Prospect, 502 East Prospect, 415 East Prospect,

400 Ravine Avenue, 419 East Prospect

- Authorizing a 15-minute extension on Wednesday night for league play at the Blair Park paddle courts.
 - The following text amendments recommended by the Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals:
 - Relaxing the regulations applicable to swimming pools.
 - Amendments to the Village's sign code to permanently authorize common exceptions for businesses.
 - Changes to maximum height and parking in the Business Park and other areas (see above).
