**Recent Village Board Meeting (October 22). The Village Board:**

- Proclaimed October as "Dysautonomia Awareness Month" and the week of October 23 as "Red Ribbon Week."
- Authorized an automatic firefighting aid agreement with the Village of Libertyville.
- Designated an additional vehicle as an authorized emergency vehicle of the Fire Department.
- Approved a site plan for LED light replacements at the CLCJAWA water plant (200 Rockland Road).
- Approved sign exemption requests at 917 Sherwood Drive and 303 Waukegan Road.
- Approved a liquor license for a new restaurant at 303 Waukegan Road (El Norte).
- Designated 406 East Prospect and 502 East Prospect as Village Historic Landmarks.
- Relaxed the regulations applicable to swimming pools.
- Scheduled a workshop regarding L-1 height, parking, and planning for the November 12 Committee-of-the-Whole.
- Provided first reading approval (no final action) to:
  - Designating 415 East Prospect, 400 Ravine Avenue, and 419 East Prospect as Village Historic Landmarks.
  - Authorizing a 15-minute extension on Wednesday night for league play at the Blair Park paddle courts.
  - Amendments to the Village's code to permanently authorize common signage exceptions for businesses.
