Recent Architectural Board of Review Meeting (November 6). The Board heard an appeal regarding a significant demolition application for 419 East Prospect Avenue and found the application to be complete.

Recent Beach Parking Ad Hoc Committee (November 7). The Committee conducted their kickoff meeting and discussed background, policy objectives, and various parking management approaches.

Upcoming Committee-of-the-Whole Meeting (November 12). The Committee will hear a presentation and update concerning the Village's Waukegan Road Corridor Study, and discuss related PCZBA recommended Zoning Code amendments.

Upcoming Village Board Meeting (November 12). The Board will consider:

- Designating 415 East Prospect Avenue, 400 Ravine Avenue, and 419 East Prospect Avenue as historic landmarks.
- Extending the hours of operation of the Park District's paddle tennis courts by 15 minutes one day per week.
- Amending the Village's code to permanently authorize common signage exceptions for businesses.
- Adopting a 2018 property tax levy estimate.
- Approving the purchase of road salt for the upcoming winter season.
- Approving a license agreement for the private use (install a fence) of Village right-of-way adjacent to 420 Evanston Avenue.
- Adopting new procedures to designate Authorized Emergency Vehicles of the Police and Fire Department.

The Historic Preservation Commission's regular meeting on November 14 is cancelled.
