Recent Committee-of-the-Whole Meeting (November 12). The Committee received a presentation and update concerning the Village's Waukegan Road Corridor Study, and set text amendments concerning the Village's light industry districts to be heard at the Village Board's next meeting on November 26.

Recent Village Board Meeting (November 12). The Board:

- Designated 415 East Prospect Avenue, 400 Ravine Avenue, and 419 East Prospect Avenue as historic landmarks.
- Extended the hours of operation of the Park District's paddle tennis courts by 15 minutes one day per week.
- Amended the Village's code to permanently authorize common signage exceptions for businesses.
- Adopted a 2018 property tax levy estimate.
- Approved the purchase of road salt for the upcoming winter season.
- Approved a license agreement for the private use (install a fence) of Village right-of-way adjacent to 420 Evanston Avenue.
- Adopted new procedures to designate Authorized Emergency Vehicles of the Police and Fire Department.
