 - Approving a plat of subdivision in unincorporated Knollwood.
 - Amendments concerning building height and parking requirements in the L-1, L-2, and S (commercial) zoning districts.
 - Amendments concerning historic preservation regulations.
 - Approval of additional engineering expenses for the 2018 roadway improvement program.
 - Amendment to a landscape waste and compost agreement with DK Organics, LLC.
