The Architectural Board of Review's December 4 meeting was cancelled.

The Beach Parking Ad Hoc Committee met December 4 and made recommendations to the Village Board concerning on-street parking near Sunrise Park and Beach.

Upcoming Village Board Meeting (December 10). The Board will:

- Designate December as National Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Month.
- Receive recommendations from the Beach Parking Ad Hoc Committee.
- Consider:
 - Approving the 2018 property tax levy.
 - Approving changes to building height and parking requirements in the L-1, L-2, and S (commercial) zoning districts.
 - Approving amendments concerning historic preservation regulations.

Upcoming Historic Preservation Commission Meeting (November 12). The Commission will conduct an initial advisory review concerning pending exterior changes to 548 East Scranton Avenue. (After receiving approval for proposed changes in July, the Illinois State Historic Preservation Office requested further changes that would make the property eligible for an incentive by preserving additional historic features.)
