Police Chief Announces Retirement



Lake Bluff Police Chief David Belmonte announced his retirement this week after 31 years of police service. His last day will be March 1, 2019. The Village will conduct a search to select Chief Belmonte's successor in early 2019.

"I could not have asked for a better community to serve, a better place to raise my family, or a better team of dedicated men and women to serve alongside," said Chief Belmonte. "My time in Lake Bluff has been an unbelievable honor and privilege that I will keep close to my heart."
