Recent Committee-of-the-Whole Meeting (April 8). The COW discussed leaf blower regulations.

Recent Village Board Meeting (April 8). The Village Board:

- Honored the public service of postal carrier Paula Nordeen.
- Recognized Arbor Day and Fair Housing Month.
- Accepted awards for the Village's budget and audit.
- Adopted a resolution as part of issuing bond debt to fund water capital projects.
- Approved contracts for water main replacements on Cambridge Lane, East Sheridan Place, and Armour Drive.
- Entered into an intergovernmental agreement with the Lake Bluff Park District for grant administration concerning improvements to Sunrise Park and Beach.
- Adopted regulations concerning small wireless facilities.
- Conducted first consideration of:
 - The [FY2020 annual budget](#).
 - Granting a special use permit to 1875 Shore Acres Drive to allow the construction of an electric lift system on the bluff.
 - Adjusting water rates.
 - Amending the liquor code to reflect the contractual management of the Lake Bluff Golf Course.

The April 10 meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission was cancelled.

Upcoming Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting (April 17). The PCZBA will consider zoning relief to allow a florist to operate at 49 & 51 Sherwood Terrace in the Village's business park.
