Recent Sustainability and Community Enhancement Ad Hoc Committee Meeting (May 6). The Committee approved circulating a final draft of the Sustainability Plan for public comment prior to a possible recommendation for adoption in June. Stay tuned next week for a final draft.

Recent Architectural Board of Review Meeting (May 7). The ABR:

- Recommended the Village Board approve construction of planter boxes at the Community Church (117 E. Scranton Ave.)
- Continued until its next meeting a site plan review to expand the parking lot at 101 Waukegan Road.

Upcoming Village Board Meeting (May 13). The Board will:

- Receive a report regarding the 2019 Lake Bluff Farmers Market.
- Consider:
 - Appointing Ed Richardson to the Senior Resources Commission.
 - Amending an agreement to film videos of Village meetings.
 - Approving a site plan for planter boxes at the Community Church (117 E. Scranton Ave.)
 - Approve engineering agreements for the reconstruction of Green Bay Road; storm sewer improvements on Bath and Tennis Club Road; and storm sewer projects on Lincoln Avenue and West Sheridan Place.
 - Entering into a construction contract for the Lincoln Avenue and West Sheridan Place storm sewer projects.
 - Employment agreements for the interim Chief of Police and the Village Administrator.
 - Liquor license amendments concerning the 2019 Downtown Block Party series.
- Inaugurate the newly elected Village Trustees and Village Clerk.
- Honor the public service of outgoing Trustees Mark Dewart and Paul Lemieux.

Upcoming Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals Meeting (May 15). The PCZBA will consider:

- A special use permit to authorize a physical fitness facility over 500 square feet at 910 Sherwood Drive (Quest Performance Training LLC)
- Floor area and side yard setback variations to allow construction of a kitchen addition and relocation of an air conditioner at 224 East Center Avenue.

- A front yard setback variation to allow construction of an open front porch at 407 East Prospect Avenue.
