LAKE BLUFF OFFERS SEMI-ANNUAL COLLECTION FIRST TWO WEEKS IN MAY

During the first two weeks of May, the Village of Lake Bluff provides its residents an opportunity to dispose of large items not picked up as part of the normal refuse collection program at no additional charge.

- Collection for Lake Bluff residents with Monday refuse collection is scheduled for Wednesday, May 6th.
- Residents with Tuesday refuse collection is scheduled on Wednesday, May 13th.
- Residents are reminded that on the designated collection day, all items are required to be placed at the curb no earlier than 4:00 p.m. the day prior to the collection.
- Household electronics, such as televisions, computers, printers, etc., and household chemicals will not be collected.

Appliances will be accepted provided that all restricted parts and/or chemicals, such as Chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) or mercury switches have been removed. All appliances must display a tag issued by a technician licensed to perform such removals, which provides proof that those substances have been removed. Residents are reminded household electronics are no longer recycled at the Public Works Recycling Center (640 Rockland Road), but collection services are available to Lake Bluff residents free of charge, with the exception of televisions, at Midwest Computer Recycling (101 Skokie Valley Rd., Lake Bluff).

The Recycling Facility is open seven days a week for residents to dispose of regular recyclable items (same items disposed of during regular collections) at no extra cost. This convenient service is

available to residents displaying a Lake Bluff vehicle sticker, Monday through Friday (from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and on Saturday and Sunday (from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.). Clothing and textiles are also collected for recycling at this location as well. Household chemicals such as paints, motor oil, and household cleaners are not accepted during any waste pick-up.
